The levels of Lead, Cadmium, Mercury, Hexavalent Chromium, Polybrominated Biphenyl (PBB) and Polybrominated Diphenyl Ether (PBDE) are all below the maximum permissible levels stipulated in the:

- Materials supplied by us
- European Union Restriction on Use of Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment Directive 2015/863 ("RoHS")
- UK Legislation Restriction of the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment Regulations 2012 (as amended)

The only exception to this is, where a grade of material is ordered by a customer where the British, European or International Standard covering the grade requires a deliberate addition of one or more of the substances in order to comply with the standard/grade requirements.

In this case, the material will contain a value of each substance in line with the standard requirements.
